Part III Passage

Please listen to the following passage, and fill in the blanks according to the passage you have heard with NO MORE THAN THREE WORDS. The passage will be read TWICE.

Last week we did a survey of students' opinions about school uniforms. Here are the results: some students love their uniforms while others hate them. Over 60 percent of the students like the idea of wearing uniforms to school because they don't want to have to think what to wear every morning. Though most students like wearing uniforms to school, more than 50 percent of the boys think that their uniforms are too old-fashioned and uncomfortable. Another common complaint from 30 percent of the students is about the design of the uniforms. One student we interviewed said that the trousers were too loose. In fact, all the students said they were unhappy with the material used to make their uniforms.

We asked the girl students to describe their ideal uniforms. Here are some of their ideas:

"It should be a modern dress with pockets. It should be made of no-iron material." "I'd like to be able to wear a skirt to school instead of trousers. It keeps me cool during the hot summer."
